Our website uses technology necessary for its operation and to offer you the best browsing experience. This means that when you visit our website, cookies or similar technologies will be placed on your computer or other device.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, smartphone or other device when you visit our website. A cookie file is stored on your device and allows us to recognise you and make your visit easier and more useful to you when you revisit our website.

Types of cookies

The length of time a cookie stays on your device depends on its type. We use two types of cookies on our website:

- Session cookies are temporary cookies which only exist during the time you use the website (or more strictly, until you close the browser after using the website). Session cookies help our website remember what you chose on the previous page, avoiding the need to re-enter information and improve your experience whilst using the website.
- Persistent cookies stay on your device after you have visited our website, so that the website remembers you the next time you use it. Persistent cookies help us identify you as a unique visitor.

To help you understand cookies and the reasons for them, we've provided a description of each cookie we use in the table below.

svSession	Used in connection with user login	12 months	Essential
SSR-caching	Used to indicate the system from which the site was rendered	1 minute	Essential
TS* cookies	Used for security and anti-fraud reasons	Session	Essential
bSession	Used for system effectiveness measurement	30 minutes	Essential
fedops.logger.X	Used for stability/effectiveness measurement	12 months	Essential
